# Solid Cedar House



Low cost 120mm square cedar timber is stacked, similar to a log house. These walls are unified vertically by steel rods and bear the vertical and lateral loads. Furthermore, they are placed throughout the site in a balanced manner in order to frame views, hide the street and neighbors, and to form the core for the wet spaces. The roof is made from the same 120mm square cedar timber by laying them as a horizontal slab, in a contrasting composition to the vertical walls.
